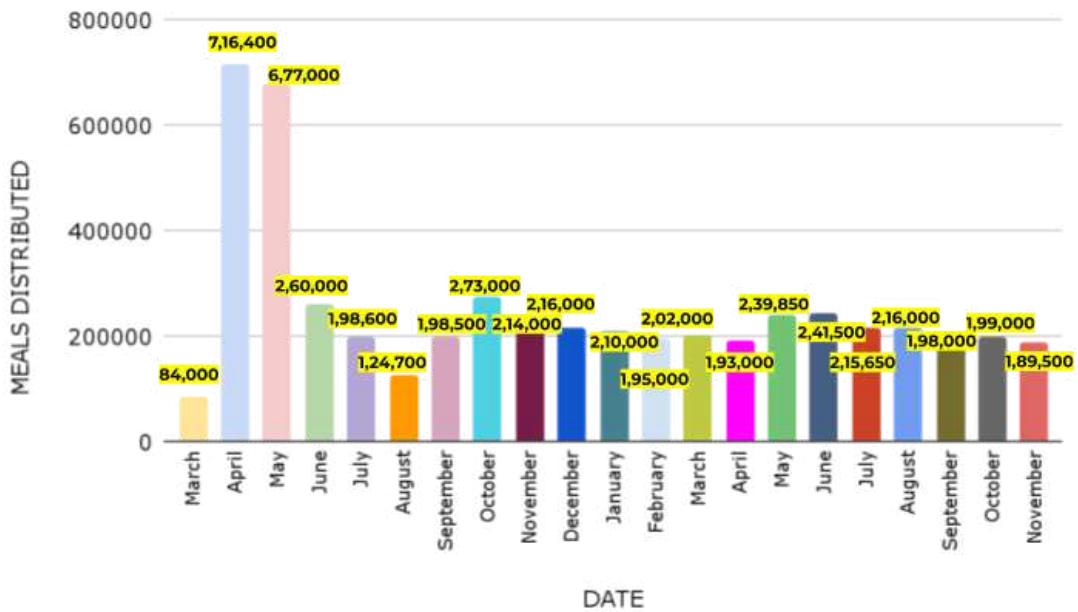
## Core Team's Visit to the Kitchen

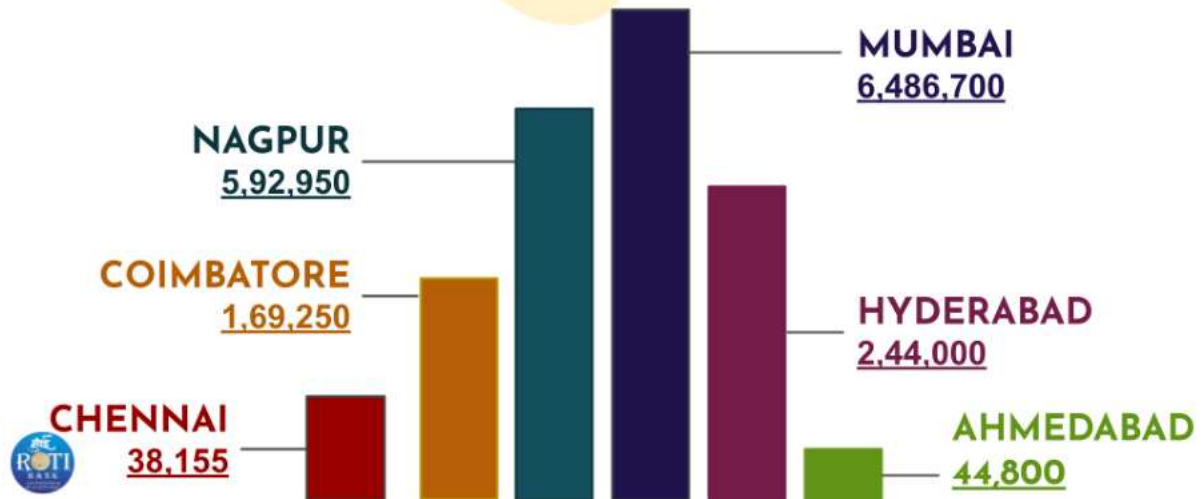
